


IT & Technical - Computers, Printer, Phones & Tablets

Four computer systems and basic colour laser printers have been ordered for our Recreation staff. Some have been using equipment graciously provided for them by others including resident associations and the like however the Foundation will be better served by using our own resources, while at the same time preserving the use of these group's limited financial resources to benefit the residents more directly.

Lodge Mangers will also be issued new phones for business use which will assist in keeping Foundation communications and data protected and secure within the organization.

The Foundation has also purchased four Android tablets for the kitchen staff in our lodges which will greatly assist them in ordering through Complete Purchasing. The cooks are also being added to our Office 365 infrastructure to enable then to collaborate with Kitchen staff in other Lodges using Microsoft Teams.

Concurrently, we are rolling out a Mobile Device Management system for our mobile devices such as phones and tablets. Our Windows and Office 365 assets are already managed by Pulseway and Backupify in addition to Microsoft's internal policies.

After trialling four Mobile Device Management systems we have decided on the use of Itarian (Comodo) Device Management. It offers a complete range of options for managing mobile devices including system locking and wiping of the systems if needed, application control, plus geolocation to assist in the recovery of lost or misplaced equipment. A big plus is that Itarian is also free to use for up to 50 devices.

These improvements are necessary to ensure the viability and survivability of the Foundation's IT and data infrastructure.
